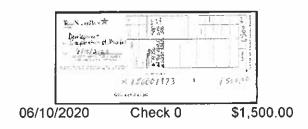

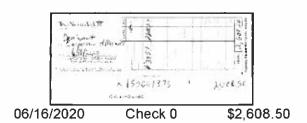

Re: TXCLASS Transfer of Funds

The 2006 Bond Reserve requires a fund balance of \$272,136.81.

The current balance is \$298,638.25. Excess funds should be moved from the account.

Recommendation: Transfer \$26,501.44 to the TXCLASS Development Corporation of Mercedes account.

Tax Revenues are first received from the State Comptroller of Public Accounts, whichever date is the later.

The required deposits to the Bond Fund for the payment of principal of and interest on the Bonds shall continue to be made as hereinabove provided until (i) the total amount on deposit in the Bond Fund and Reserve Fund is equal to the amount required to fully pay and discharge all Parity Obligations (principal and interest) then Outstanding or (ii) the Bonds are no longer Outstanding.

Accrued interest, if any, and capitalized interest, if any, received from the issuance of any Parity Obligations shall be taken into consideration and shall reduce the amount of the monthly deposits hereinabove required to be deposited into the Bond Fund from the Pledged Revenues. Additionally, any proceeds of the Bonds not required to construct the Projects shall be deposited into the Bond Fund and shall be taken into consideration and shall reduce the amount of monthly deposits required to be deposited into the Bond Fund from the Pledged Revenues. Lastly, any interest income transferred to the Bond Fund from the Reserve Fund or the Construction Fund shall reduce the amount of monthly deposits required to be deposited into the Bond Fund from the Pledged Revenues.

SECTION 13: Reserve Fund. The Corporation agrees and covenants to maintain on the books and records of the Corporation a separate and special fund or account to be known as the "The Development Corporation of Mercedes, Inc. Reserve Fund" (the "Reserve Fund"), which fund or account shall be a special banking fund maintained at a Depository. All Pledged Revenues deposited to the credit of such fund or account shall be used solely for the payment of the principal of and interest on the Parity Obligations when (whether at maturity, upon a redemption date or any interest payment date) other funds available for such purposes are insufficient, and, in addition, may be used to the extent not required to maintain the Required Reserve, to pay, or provide for the payment of, the final principal amount of a series of Parity Obligations so that such series of Parity Obligations is no longer deemed to be Outstanding as such term is defined herein. Once the Required Reserve is on deposit in the Reserve Fund, any interest income earned on money deposited in the Reserve Fund shall be transferred by the Corporation to the Bond Fund.

The total amount to be accumulated and maintained in the Reserve Fund by reason of the issuance of the Bonds shall be \$272,136.81 (the "Required Reserve"), and immediately following the delivery of the Bonds to the Purchasers, there shall be deposited to the credit of the Reserve Fund the Required Reserve.

As and when Additional Obligations are delivered or incurred, the Required Reserve shall be increased, if required, to an amount equal to the lesser of (i) average annual Debt Service (calculated on a Fiscal Year basis) for all Parity Obligations then Outstanding (after giving effect to the issuance of the Additional Obligations), as determined on the date each series of Additional Obligations are delivered or incurred, as the case may be or (ii) the maximum amount in a reasonably required reserve fund that can be invested without restriction as to yield pursuant to Subsection (d) of section 148 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and regulations promulgated thereunder. Any additional amount required to be accumulated and maintained in the Reserve Fund shall be accumulated by the deposit to the credit of the Reserve

BYLAWS OF THE DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION OF MERCEDES, INC. A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION MERCEDES, TEXAS

ARTICLE I

1.01 The principal office of the Development Corporation of Mercedes, Inc. (the "corporation") shall be at City Hall, 400 South Ohio, Mercedes, Texas 78570, and the name of its registered agent at such address is Richard Garcia.

ARTICLE II PURPOSES

2.01 The corporation is a non-profit corporation organized pursuant to the Development Corporation Act of 1979, as amended, and specifically governed by Section 4A of said Act. The purpose of the Corporation is to promote, assist, and enhance economic and industrial development in accordance with the Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE III DIRECTORS

- 3.01 The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors (the "Board") which shall be composed in its entirety of persons appointed by, and whose terms of offices shall be fixed by, the governing body of the City of Mercedes, Texas (the "City").
- 3.02 In addition, the Board may, by contract, resolution, or otherwise, gives general or limited or special power and authority to officers and employees of the corporation to transact the general business or any special business of the corporation, and may give powers of attorney to agents of the corporation to transact any special business requiring such authorization.
- 3.03 The authorized number of Directors of this Board shall be seven (7), appointed in the manner provided in the Articles of Incorporation. In accordance with section 4A of the Development Corporation Act of 1979, as amended, Board members serve at the pleasure of the governing body of the City. Two (2) members shall be the President of the Mercedes Area Chamber of Commerce, or representative from the Chamber of Commerce, and the outgoing Mayor of the City of Mercedes, or representative from the City of Mercedes. No member of the City

- Commission may be a voting member of the Development Corporation of Mercedes.
- 3.04 The Board, acting for the corporation, shall have and exercise all of the rights, powers, privileges, authority, and functions given by the general laws of Texas to nonprofit corporations incorporated under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, as amended (Article 1396-1.01, et seq., Texas Revised Civil Statutes Annotated) and other such powers given by the Development Corporation Act of 1979, as amended (Article 5190.6, Texas Revised Civil Statutes Annotated).
- 3.05 The Board is hereby required to perform the following duties:
 - 1. The Board shall develop an overall economic and industrial development strategy for the City.
 - 2. The corporation's focus will be primarily in the areas of business retention and expansion, formation of new businesses, business attraction, and the enhancement of community assets to promote economic development.
 - 3. Assurance of accountability for all sales tax funds and all other funds received and expended by the corporation.
 - 4. The corporation shall make reports to the City Commission to include a review of revenues received and expended by the corporation from the City.
- 3.06 The corporation is authorized to do that which the Board deems desirable to accomplish any of the powers or duties set out or alluded to hereinabove and in accordance with State Law.
- 3.07 The annual meeting of the Board shall be held at the Principal Office of the Corporation in January. The Board shall meet in regular meeting at least once each month or on an on call basis at a place and time to be determined by the President and shall be conducted pursuant to all applicable laws. Special meetings of the Board may be called by the President or any three (3) Directors on three (3) days notice to each Director, either personally, by mail, or by telephone. Directors may execute written waivers of notice of any meeting. All meetings shall be conducted in accordance with the requirements of the Texas Open Meeting Act. All meetings of the Board of Directors shall be within the city limits of the City of Mercedes.
- 3.08 Regular attendance at the Board meetings is required of all members. Three (3) consecutive absences and/or attendance reflecting absences constituting 50% of the meetings over a 12-month period may constitute the need for replacement of a member. In that event, the member will be counseled by the Board and

- subsequently, the Board may submit, in writing, to the City Manager of the City of Mercedes a request that the member be replaced by the Mercedes City Commission.
- 3.09 For the purpose of convening a meeting and transacting business, a quorum shall consist of four (4) Directors. If a quorum shall not be present at any meeting of the Directors, the Directors present thereat may recess the meeting from time to time, without notice other than announcement at the meeting until a quorum shall be present. Any action taken by the Board shall require the affirmative vote of no less than four (4) Directors.
- 3.10 The Board shall be responsible to the Mercedes City Commission for the proper discharge of the Board's duties as assigned in these bylaws and by the Articles of Incorporation. Its authority is limited by applicable laws, contracts that may be entered into with the City or other entities, and budget and fiduciary responsibilities. The Board, on behalf of the corporation, may request that administrative departments of the City provide assistance to the corporation and the Board in fulfilling its duties. The City and the Board may agree to reimburse any such administrative department's budget for the cost of such services so provided. The corporation may seek legal assistance through the City Attorney or a separate attorney engaged by it for that purpose.
- 3.11 In addition to the Mayor and City Commissioners, the City Manager of the City of Mercedes shall serve as an ex-officio non-voting member of the Board.

ARTICLE IV NOTICES

4.01 Whenever, under the provisions of the governing statutes or of these bylaws, notice is required to be given to any Director, it shall be construed to mean notice in writing, by mail or in person, addressed to such Director at address as appears on the books of the corporation, and such notice shall be deemed to be given at the time when the same shall be thus mailed. Whenever any notice is required to be given under the provisions of the statutes or bylaws, a waiver thereof in writing signed by the person or persons entitled to said notice, whether before or after the time stated therein, shall be deemed equivalent thereto.

ARTICLE V OFFICERS

5.01 The elected officers of the corporation shall be a President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer. Any two (2) offices may be held by the same person, except the offices of the President and Secretary.
