Project Understanding

Freese and Nichols, Inc. (FNI) understands that the City of Mercedes is seeking professional engineering services to future land use assumptions. The land use assumptions will be utilized in a future project for water and wastewater master planning.

Scope of Work

- Land Use and Development Meeting: FNI will meet with the City to discuss population and land
 use assumptions, and projected growth rates. Future water and wastewater service areas for the

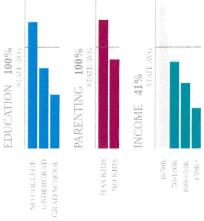

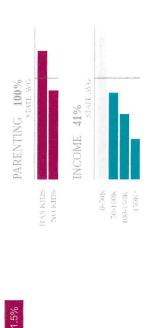

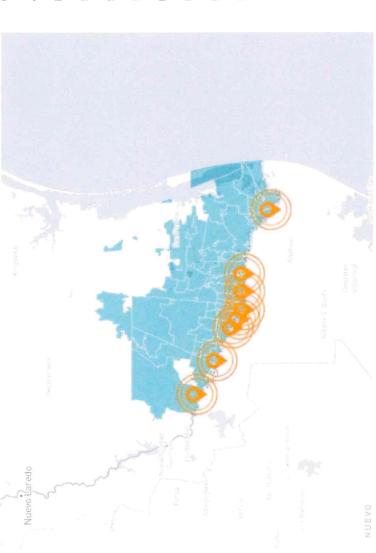
